**WISCONSIN'S TOP COP, ATTORNEY GENERAL JB VAN HOLLEN,
ENDORSES SENATOR DARLING'S RE-ELECTION**

(Germantown)... State Senator Alberta Darling announced today the endorsement of her re-election by Attorney General J.B. Van Hollen, Wisconsin's Top Cop.

"Since taking the oath of office as Attorney General, as I promised during the campaign, I have set out to fight crime and restore integrity to the Department of Justice," Van Hollen said. "Senator Darling has been a great help in our efforts and I need her in the Senate to continue this fight."

Van Hollen and Darling are both committed to ensuring the integrity of elections. The Attorney General has sent undercover agents into the field to find fraud in the city of Milwaukee resulting in prosecutions. Darling supports Voter ID to stop election fraud. In contrast, Sheldon Wasserman opposes Voter ID and even opposes requiring proof of citizenship before voting.

"Election fraud is a serious crime, and I want to return to the Senate to pass Voter ID," said Darling. "The Attorney General and I will continue to fight to make sure that Wisconsin elections are accurate and free from fraud."

The Attorney General and Darling are both committed to getting tough with criminal illegal aliens. Van Hollen has taken the lead in participating in coordinated immigration enforcement activities, which will take more criminal illegal aliens off the streets.

Senator Darling voted to stop illegal immigrants from getting discounted tuition, taxpayer-funded health care, and drivers' licenses. In contrast, Wasserman supports taxpayer-funded health care and drivers' licenses for illegal immigrants. He even opposes requiring proof of citizenship before voting.
